

PGC Code of Conduct /Liability Release

PGC requires each parent and player agree to the ZERO TOLERANCE code of conduct. Safety is our number one concern. Below is a list of conduct violations.

- Unsportsmanlike conduct, including abusive language, cheating, club throwing, disrespect to volunteers, officials or fellow participants, or abuse of golf course property.
- Conduct not becoming of a PGC Junior Golfer, such as acting in anger or creating other distractions
- Not following directions of coach
- Physical abuse, threat of physical abuse, verbal abuse, slander or libel towards other players, parents, coaches.

If a Junior Golfer is found to be in violation of code of conduct, he/she will be asked to stop participation and leave facility. A notice will be sent immediately to parent/guardian. Depending on severity of violation, participant may be removed without refund.

This agreement releases Princeton Golf Course from all liability relating to injuries that may occur during junior linkers golf program. By signing this agreement, we agree to hold Princeton Golf Course staff and volunteers entirely free from any liability, including financial responsibility for injuries incurred, regardless of whether injuries are caused by negligence. We also acknowledge there are risks involved in golf. We fully understand and agree to the above terms by signing this document.
